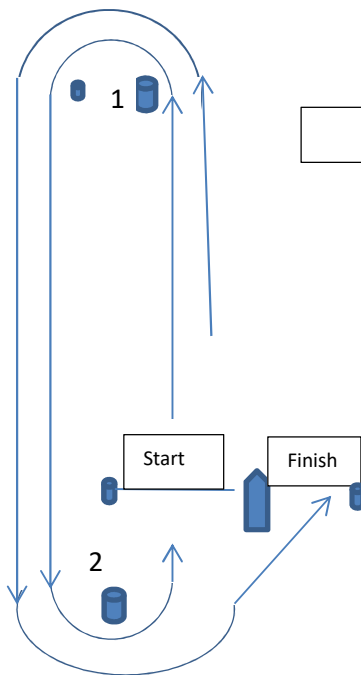


Courses shown below are E4 & W5. The number denotes the number of LEGS to be sailed.

E.G. a "E2" course when posted will be: Start – 1(P), F line closed, – 2(P) -Finish. ** Finish line closed on *downwind* (from MK 1 to 2) leg.

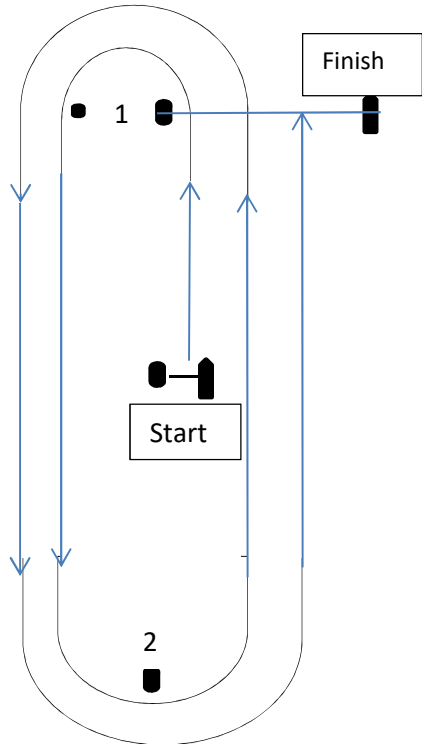
A W3 course will be Start – 1(P) – 2(P) – Finish

Notes Course E4

Mk 1 includes offset if present.

Course: - Start – 1(P), F line closed, - 2(P) - 1(P) - F line closed, - 2(P) - FINISH

NB finish line closed on downwind leg

Downwind leg is defined as mark 1 to mark 2

Notes Course W5

Mk 1 includes OFFSET if present.

Course: - Start -1(P) -2(P) -1(P) -2(P) - FINISH

NB Shorten Course

Should an E4 course be shortened to an E2 course, multiple sound signals will be made as the leading boat is rounding mark 2. Flag K will be displayed on the signal boat positioned at the starboard end of the finish line.
