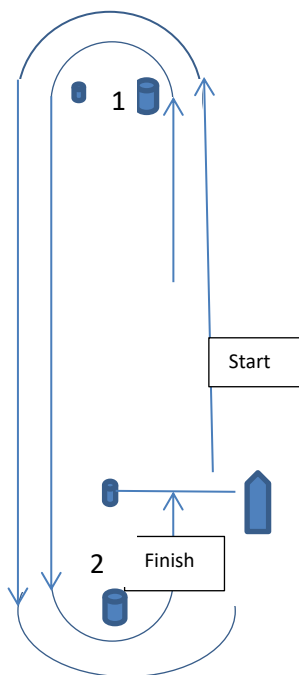


Courses shown below are E4 & W5. The number denotes the number of LEGS to be sailed.

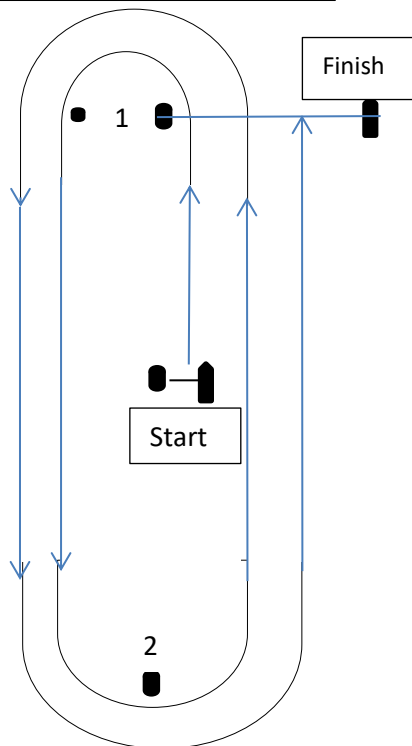
NB a "E2" course when posted will be Start – 1(P), S&F line closed, – 2(P) -Finish. **\*\*Start & Finish line closed on downwind (from MK 1 to 2) leg.\*\***

A W3 course will be Start – 1(P), -S&F line closed, – 2(P) – Finish **\*\*Start & Finish line closed on downwind (MK 1 to 2) leg.\*\***

### Notes Course E4

Mk 1 includes offset

Course:- Start – 1(P), S&F line closed, - 2(P) - 1(P) - S&F line closed, 2(P) - FINISH \*\*

Start & Finish line MAY be the same and

**\*\* Both are closed on downwind legs \*\***

Downwind leg is defined as mark 1 to mk 2

### Notes Course W5

Mk 1 includes OFFSET if present.

Course:- Start-1(P) S&F line closed, - 2 (P) -1(P) S&F line closed, - 2(P) - FINISH \*\*

**\*\*Start line is CLOSED on downwind legs\*\***

Downwind leg is defined as mark1 to mk 2

### NB Shorten Course

Should an E4 course be shortened to a E2 course, multiple sound signals will be made as the leading boat is rounding mark 2. Flag K will be displayed on the signal boat positioned at the starboard end of the finish line.
